INTRODUCTION TO CIMSA

Center for Indonesian Medical Students' Activities (CIMSA) is a non-profit and non governmental organization that is independent, nationalist, non-political and non partisan with activity based programs. CIMSA consists of 6 standing committees related to health issues: Reproductive Health including AIDS, Public Health, Medical Education, Human Right and Peace, Research Exchange and Professional Exchange. Having 18 active locals throughout Indonesia, CIMSA is affiliated with International Federation of Medical Students' Association (IFMSA), the biggest students' organization in the world who has been recognized by United Nations.

With the mission to empower medical students to be able to actively learn and create, and also to plan strategies and execute movements to improve nation's health and well-being, CIMSA continues its struggle to create a healthier, more secure and more prosperous Indonesia where people can enjoy equal opportunities in education and health and also in effort to improve lives and also reach prosperity and social justice.

INTRODUCTION TO IFMSA

The International Federation of Medical Students' Associations (IFMSA) is a non-profit, non-governmental organization representing associations of medical students worldwide. IFMSA was founded in 1951 and currently maintains 125 National Member Organizations from 118 countries across six continents, representing a network of 1.3 million medical students.

IFMSA envisions a world in which medical students unite for global health and are equipped with the knowledge, skills and values to take on health leadership roles locally and globally, so to shape a sustainable and healthy future.



IFMSA is recognized as a nongovernmental organization within the United Nations' system and the World Health Organization; and works in collaboration with the World Medical Association.

INTRODUCTION TO SCORE

The standing Committee on Research Exchange (SCORE) is one of the 6 standing committees of the International Federation of Medical Students Association (IFMSA). SCORE was founded in 1991 as the Standing committee on Electives Exchange (SCOEE). Because the term 'Electives' was too confusing, in 1998 the name of this IFMSA standing committee was changed to SCORE.

SCORE supervises and co-ordinates the IFMSA research exchange program, which on a national level is run by individual NMOs of IFMSA. SCORE is an assembly of National Officers on Research Exchange (NOREs) who represent their correspondent IFMSA NMOs. Along with the SCORE Director, his/her development and regional assistants and the SCORE supervisory Board, they act as the governing body of SCORE.

Presently, SCORE involves more than 70 active NMOs, offering over 2800 research projects to provide over 1800 medical students worldwide the opportunity to participate in IFMSA research exchange program and learn the basic principles of medical research such as literature studies, collecting data, scientific writing, lab work, statistics and ethical aspects related to the medicine

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

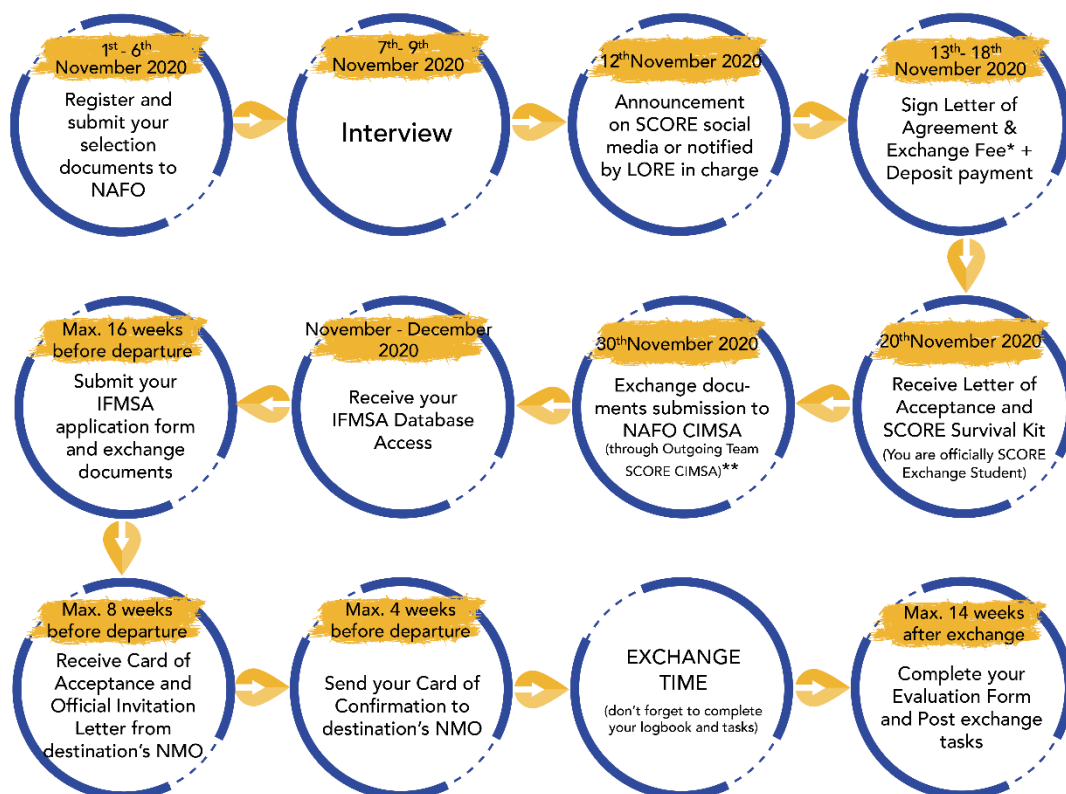
- Contact NAFO to buy the application form (IDR 150K)
- Pay the Application Form via transfer to Treasurer SCORE (BNI bank on behalf Muhammad Agam Rayhan, account number 0977414647)
- After payment, you'll receive the AF from NAFO. Fill the AF and prepare these documents:
 1. Motivation letter (300 words max)
 2. Latest GPA transcript
 3. English Proficiency Certificate
 4. CV (Has to include your organizational experience)
- Submit the documents and the AF you have filled to nafo.score@cimsa.or.id with subject: 2nd batch RE - Name - University
Example: 2nd batch RE _Monika Herliana_Universitas Indonesia
- Application submission deadline: November, 6th 2020 23:59 (GMT+7)
- Documents will go through selection process
